A \$350 scholarship will be awarded for the 2004-2005 academic year.



For John A. Logan College continuing students

The recipient will be selected by the John A. Logan College Scholarship Committee based on recommendations from the AAWCC screening committee.

Selection will be based on the following eligibility requirements:

- A. Recipient must be a continuing John A. Logan College student.
- B. Recipient must have a grade-point-average of 3.500 or better.

C. Recipient must be enrolled for a minimum of six semester hours.

Interested Students Should

complete the check list to determine eligibility. If eligible, student must complete a general scholarship application that is available in the Foundation Office in Room B33.

Attach to the general scholarship application an essay (500 to 1000 words) focusing on the topic of how change has influenced your life and your decision to pursue higher education. The topic refers to the changes we must make in our lives and how we deal with those changes.

Each application must have two references from John A. Logan College faculty or staff. The references must be in writing.
